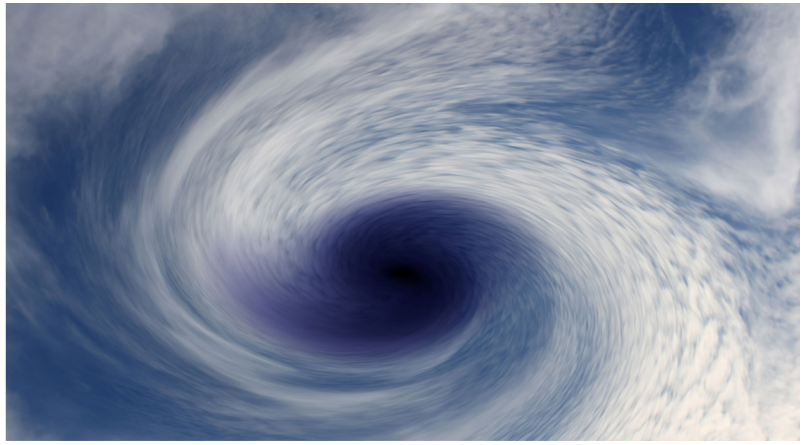

- 1 gallon of water per person per day (three-day supply)
- Non-perishable food (three-day supply)
- Manual can opener
- Battery operated radio/NOAA weather radio with extra batteries
- Cell phone with charger
- Flashlight and extra batteries
- Prescription medication
- First Aid Kit
- Personal Hygiene Items
- Baby care items (formula, diapers, bottles, etc)
- Pet care items (food, water, leash, etc)
- Cash
- Copies of important documents, such as insurance policies and bank records, in a waterproof container
- Complete change of clothes for each person
- Sturdy shoes/rain boots
- Blankets/Sleeping Bags
- Towels
- Tarp and garbage bags
- Aluminum foil and plastic bags
- Plastic utensils, cups and plates
- Books, games and playing cards
- Work gloves
- Tool kit
- Matches in a waterproof container
- Whistle to signal for help
- Paper and Pencil
- Local Map
